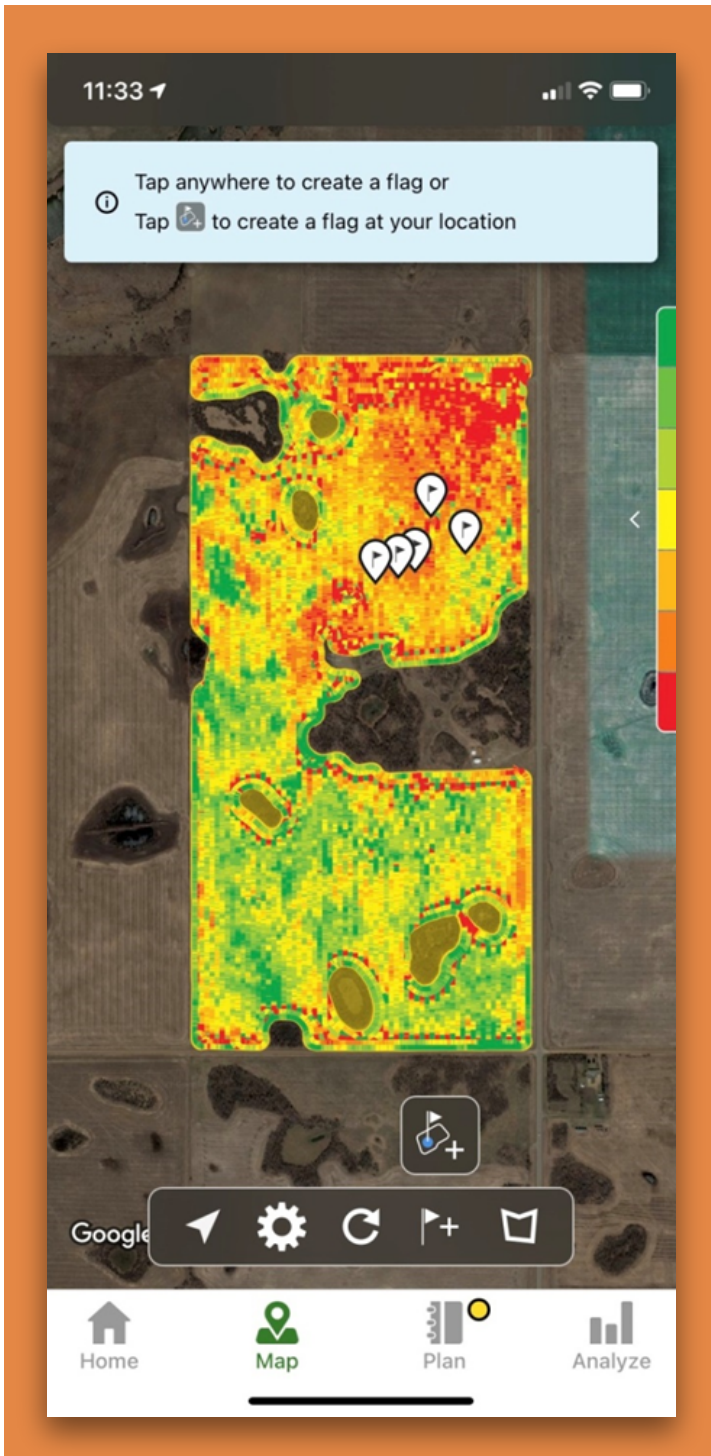

HARVEST SCOUTING



As the sprayers, swathers and combines roll across the fields this fall, remember that this is not only the wrap up to harvest '22, but the beginning of the groundwork for 2023. Now is a great time to take note of weeds or diseases that may have caused you issues during this growing season and start thinking about how to address them going forward.

For things like weed control and disease management, this can be a great time to document issues and to help make future decisions for that field. See some suspicious wild oat patches that may be Group 1 or Group 2 resistant? Seeing Canada thistle, toadflax or mayweed patches increasing, or showing up in new places? Or maybe you suspect Aphanomyces or Club Root in that low spot where the crop died prematurely. It's never been easier to take note of these things right from the combine without a lot of effort. Anybody running John Deere equipment has access to a free MyJohnDeere account and by using the Operations Center Mobile App, you can easily flag and label trouble spots in your field right on your phone or tablet.



You can name the flags, create notes for them and even take pictures that are tied to the location for future reference. Flags can also be sorted into categories, so later on you will know at a glance if you have flagged a rock or a weed for example. For more detail on adding flags, check out the YouTube video called **“John Deere Connect Mobile - Create and view flags in Connect Mobile”**

This is just one of the many ways that MyJohnDeere can help make it easy to document and store all your activities and observations for your fields. If you have equipment that came with a Modular Telematics Gateway (MTG) and aren't using this free App and website, you are missing out on having every operation in the field documented and being able to track your equipment status in near real time. All of your operations can be preloaded and pushed to the display in the tractor or sprayer, so you don't have to type in the field names, operations, products and rates at the edge of the field before you start.
